A Message in Spirituality

Spirituality in practice may be the best way to describe the contributions of two of the most active members of the Columbus Cum Christo movement who entered their fifth day earlier this year—Tsuneo Miqashira (Men's 71st) and Father Tom Cadden (Men's 105).

In addition to their contributions as spiritual leaders, both men demonstrated unparalleled strength, selflessness and kindness.

As a spiritual director for Cum Christo, Father Tom's influence was far reaching. Tsuneo, on the other hand, touched many lives by serving on dozens of weekend teams (admittedly preferring Women's weekends!) and being on hand for Ultreyas on as spiritual director.

The focus of Father Cadden's ministries included the poor and vulnerable, the disenfranchised, and the lost and forsaken. He logged countless hours in soup kitchens, and shelters. He worked with immigrants, refugees and embraced those with AIDS. Father worked many Cum Christo teams and was in team formation for the Men's 139th when he died in an automobile accident.

Both men suffered severely from various physical ailments, For Tsuneo, one of those medical problems led to him receiving a kidney from his sister in 1983. The procedure was performed to give him a "few more years" of life. As usual, Tsuneo pleasantly surprised everyone and stretched his time to twenty years.

Tsuneo was born in Hawaii February 8th, 1925. He served in the U.S. army from 1944 to 1946. He was ordained the United Church of Christ. His active pastorate was at Dublin Community Church. He and his beloved Ella are the parents of two sons and one daughter. His children and two grandsons were the joys of his life, along with his love for God, his church and Cum Christo.

Father Cadden was born April 24, 1930, in Chillicothe. He was ordained August 27, 1955. He served many parishes—the most recent of which was Our Lady of Victory in Columbus.
