Applications, especially, are challenging because they are mailed to the Application Processor's home address, and this position changes every two years. If someone has an old application and it is mailed to the wrong address, that application might not be processed in the timeliest manner, and that individual may miss the cut-off for the weekend.

Unfortunately this happens too often, but if we are diligent in making sure we use updated applications and address Cum Christo communications correctly, we can eliminate these problems. *(continued next page)*

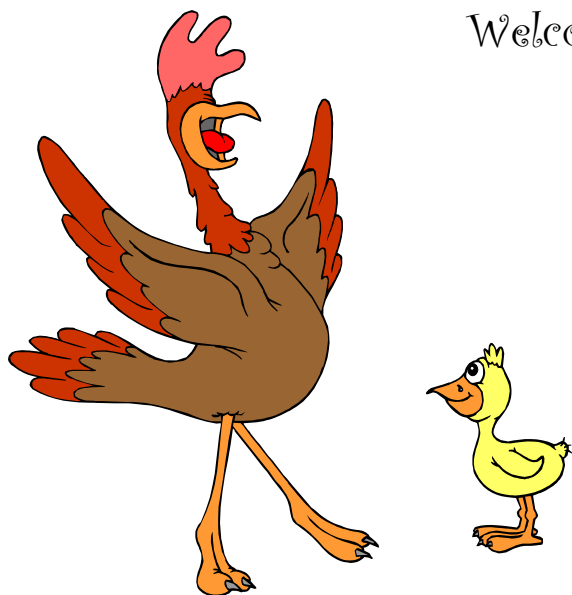
Lay Directors Continued:

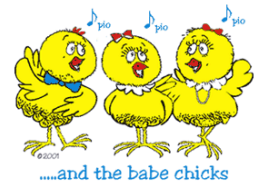
