The world celebrated the millennium last January 1st. As an engineer, I know that factually the *real* next millennium starts January 1, 2001. It will pass with little if any fanfare. Isn't that a lot like our faith story?

Many celebrated persons and children were born of the leaders of the political machine that ruled over Israel during Jesus' time. Yet the most impactful birth was not of a great politician, but of a tiny child born of obscure parents in a remote city, in a simple manger. 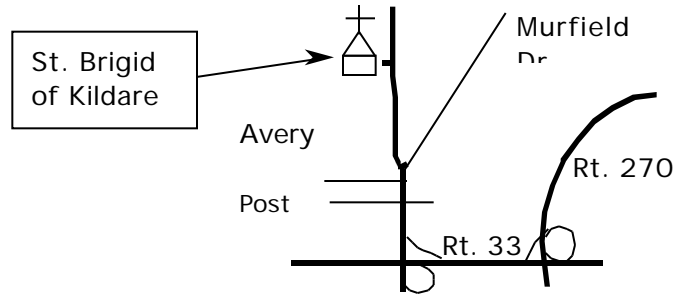
***KITCHEN AND FOOD :** Please call Terri Turner W101 (740) 964-0850 (H) to volunteer either as a day steward or to help prepare a meal. Fridays are particularly hard to staff. If you are neither a sponsor nor the spouse (or family) of a team member or candidate participating in the Weekend, sacrifice the time: call and offer your help. Also call Terri if you are planning to donate any food for the Weekend. As always, your help is welcomed and NEEDED .*

***PALANCA:** The essence of Palanca is a message of sacrifice. Write extra Palanca notes addressed "Dear Babe Chick" for candidates you do not know. Palanca from strangers is powerful stuff. GENERAL Palanca is introduced on Friday afternoon; deliver it as early as possible Friday morning. PERSONAL Palanca from sponsors, spouse/family, and guardian angels is introduced on Saturday afternoon; deliver it by mid-morning Saturday and write your relationship to the candidate on the envelope. Palanca from the community is distributed Saturday evening; deliver it no later than mid-day Saturday . Palanca in the form of gifts is distributed late Sunday afternoon before the Closing.*

***SERENADE :** Sunday - Will begin promptly at 6:00 AM. Please do not bring children. For those interested, breakfast at TeeJay's on Dublin Road immediately following the Serenade.*

CLOSING

The Closing will be Sunday, October 29, 2000, 7:00 PM, at St. Brigid of Kildare Catholic Church, 7179 Avery Rd in Dublin. From Rt. 270, exit Rt. 33 West, towards Marysville. Exit at the first exit, turn North on Avery Road. Avery road turns left in .8 miles, the second street past the light at Post Road. The church entrance is on the left, .9 miles after the left turn. To offer assistance with Closing arrangements and refreshments, please call Tom and Kathy Corroto at 764-9335. Bringing children or guests to the closing is inappropriate. All Cum Christos and other Cursillistas are encouraged to attend the closing to support the Babe Chicks.

Did you know...

Did you know that you could sponsor your Pastor? Even though we are a lay movement, clergy are welcome as candidates on any weekend. They are often a "tough sell." Study them as you study any environment. Maybe laity sponsoring clergy is not the appropriate approach for your Pastor. Maybe having a peer sponsor them would be more effective. Don't just give up when faced with resistance. As in exercise, resistance is what challenges our faith to make it grow stronger. Consider sponsoring the clergy you know into the movement.

It's a fact...

It's a fact that Cum Christo thrives due to the generous volunteers who give their time to do the work that needs doing to keep Pre Cum Christo, Weekends, and Post Cum Christo happening. When I sat down to count how many people are involved in keeping the center's operation going, I lost track at over 200. Secretariat and Leaders School, the Permanent Ultreya Team (PUT) and the Pre Cum Christo Regional and Church Coordinators, the Weekend Section and Weekend Teams and the Closing Church Committees, Sponsors, Office and Communications and Administrative functions, Bill Paying, Building Cleaning and Maintenance, Ultreya attendees, and those throughout Central Ohio who group and do Palanca on behalf of Cum Christo. There is always room for more. There is always work to be done. 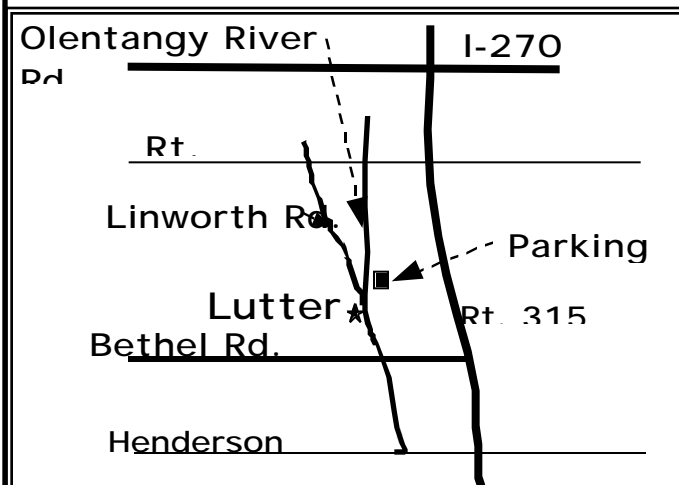
