Facility Upgrades -Service Steve Cunningham M128

Over the summer, the initial phase of work on the building has been completed. First, additional electrical power has been provided to the property by AEP. Second, security lighting has been added to the parking lot. The cost of these upgrades was shared between Cum Christo and Holy Cross Parish.

In the coming months, the electricity within the Cum Christo center will be worked on for the kitchen appliances and equipment, the catacombs, and the rest of the building where needed. Quotes have been received for adequately air-conditioning the Rollo room and Chapel both in terms of cooling capacity and noise level. Consideration of doing more than that has been shelved due to budget limitations.

Finally, as you may have heard, we are discussing the possibility of transforming the east side of the first floor into a multi-purpose room that would serve as a larger meeting room for Ultreyas and a gathering space for Holy Cross Parish. A committee is being formed to see how this can be implemented in a way that serves the joint needs of the Holy Cross Parish and renewal groups using the building.

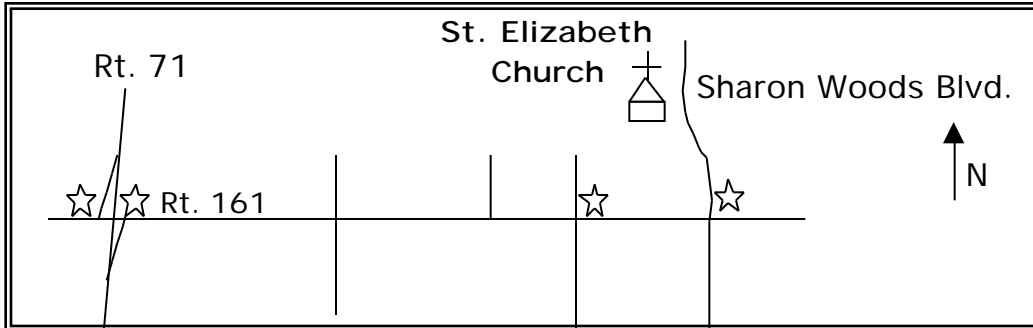

If you are neither a sponsor, nor the spouse (or family) of a team member or candidate participating in the Weekend, sacrifice the time: call and offer your help. Also call Terri if you are planning to donate any food for the Weekend. As always, your help is **welcomed** and **NEEDED**.

PALANCA: The essence of Palanca is a message of sacrifice. Write extra Palanca notes addressed "Dear Babe Chick" for candidates you do not know. Palanca from strangers is powerful stuff. **GENERAL** Palanca is introduced on Friday afternoon; deliver it as early as possible Friday morning. **PERSONAL** Palanca from sponsors, spouse/family, and guardian angels is introduced on Saturday afternoon; deliver it by mid-morning Saturday and write your relationship to the candidate on the envelope. Palanca from the community is distributed Saturday evening; deliver it no later than mid-day Saturday so it can be sorted and evenly distributed. Palanca in the form of gifts is distributed late Sunday afternoon before the Closing.

Weekend Reminders...Be respectful of the weekend by not ringing the doorbell outside of the hours of 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Palanca can be deposited in the slot provided in the left door.

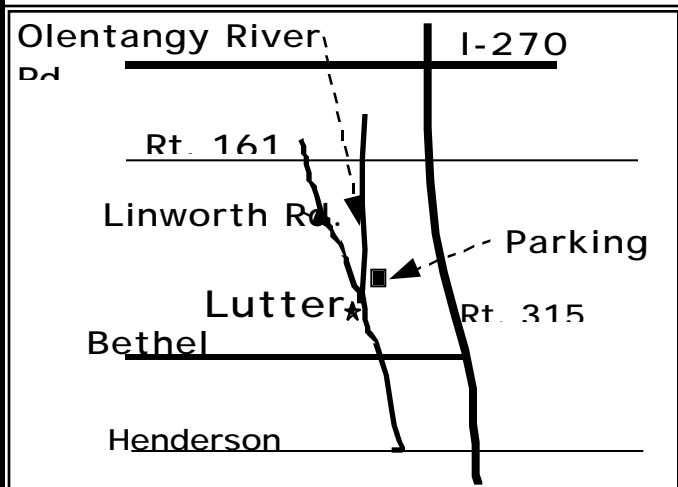
