Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Men's 157<sup>th</sup> Weekend (October 1 – 4) is fast approaching, and we are looking forward to holding it in our new Weekend venue, The Ministry Center at St. James the Less Church. I ask for your special prayers for our Weekend Teams – although the Ministry Center is very lovely and will definitely meet our Weekend needs, still, it is not the Cum Christo Center that we have all become accustomed to, and our Teams will need to make adjustments to the ways that certain details had always been carried out in our CC Center. Just an example: the Ministry Center has been freshly painted, and we have been asked to not use tape, other sticky hangers, or tacks to hang up our posters so as to not mar the fresh paint. What to do?? Well, one of our forward-thinking Team members has constructed a free-standing frame that will hold and display those carefully and lovingly made posters. Other minor but important changes are needed as well. The Teams will have to adjust to a new layout, different sleeping quarters, etc., so as you can see, these Weekends will be a little more challenging for them, and extra prayer, palanca and sacrifice is needed on their behalf.

The posters will be moved to our CC Center after the Weekend so they will be in place for all of us to view at the Ultreyas following the Weekends! Please be sure to attend those Ultreyas and welcome our new babe chicks. Also note, that all Ultreyas will continue to be held at our CC Center, with the exception of our Satellite Ultreyas.

The Ministry Center is a part of the St. James the Less Parish complex at 1652 Oakland Park Avenue. We are asked to enter via the East Driveway (we will have a sign in place). Entrance to the Ministry Center is at the rear of the complex.

**Sponsors:** Please do not drop off your candidate before 7 PM on Thursday evening. There is a food pantry at the complex that operates between the hours of 5–7 PM, and people are walking through the parking lot. Please be cautious and watchful for pedestrians. Also, it is best if you can drop off your palanca on Thursday as it will simplify the task of the palanca sorters.

## **From the Lay Director (cont'd):**

**Serenade:** Serenade will begin at 6 AM Sunday morning, as usual. The community is asked to be especially quiet upon entering the complex, as it is located in a residential area. So please, avoid slamming car doors, loud talking, using a remote to lock your car that will cause a beep, etc. Once there, please follow the directions of Team members who will show you where to enter and the path to follow to the second floor for serenading.

**Palanca:** Please do **NOT** bring your palanca to the Ministry Center except during candidate drop-off on Thursday or Serenade on Sunday morning. The door to the Ministry Center is kept locked at all times, and the doorbell is very loud and rings throughout the entire building, which would be very interruptive to the Weekend. There is no drop box or mail slot at the Ministry Center. During the weekend, palanca can be dropped off at our Cum Christo Center and placed in the mail drop box. We hope to have someone available during daytime hours to accept food palanca and other larger items, which will then be transported to the Ministry Center. The deadline for dropping palanca at the CC Center is 10 AM Sunday. Palanca dropped off after that time cannot be transported to the Ministry Center.

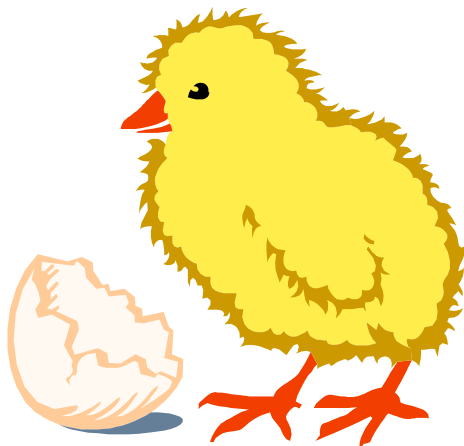

For these Weekends, let’s once again amaze our candidates with our outpouring of love, prayer and sacrifice. Perhaps we could all consider making Weekend palanca an act of Apostolic Action by our prayer and share groups.

**Help Needs:** Help will be needed on Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 10 AM. At the Cum Christo Center, beds, mattresses, and all Weekend supplies will be loaded onto a truck for transport to the Ministry Center at St. James. Sonny Beem is coordinating this effort – if you are able to help, even if for just a short time, please contact him ([teambeem@gmail.com](mailto:teambeem@gmail.com) or cell #296-9330). Also at 10 AM, Ann Finn will be organizing the pre-Weekend cleaning and move-in at the Ministry Center. Cleaning chores should be fairly light and consist mainly of a little dusting, sweeping, and perhaps dusting down of the ceramic walls in the bathrooms. 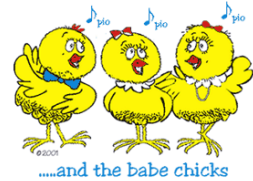

We believe in the ultimate value of Cum Christo. We believe it is important, significant, and worth the price we pay to keep it active, alive and well for Jesus Christ and new babe chicks.

When each of us made our Cum Christo Weekend we were changed. We were on fire. We were enthusiastic. We were motivated. We loved Jesus Christ and we were anxious to share Him and our Weekend with others and lead others to Christ. We were excited to get others to experience the Cum Christo Weekend since it meant so much to us. So now, what will you do to keep Cum Christo “*active, alive and well?*” The very first action we ask of you is to pray daily for the Cum Christo Movement and its leaders. The second action we ask of you is to pray and ask yourself if you are called to serve in some capacity in the Cum Christo Movement. Interested? Read on.

**COMING, A NEW PROCESS! A new way of doing things for the spiritual growth and greater good of the Cum Christo Movement and its members!**

After much prayer, reflection and discussion, Leaders School has approved a major change in how Cum Christo will go about discerning leaders for all leadership positions including team members. It is the new open and inclusive *Leadership Discernment Process* which will provide many opportunities for the Holy Spirit and Cursillistas to be active and alive in the Cum Christo Movement.

“For where two or three or more are gathered in my name, there I am among you.” Matt. 18:20

Without going into great detail, we present the Process for your reading.

**The Leader Discernment Process**

All Columbus Cum Christo leadership positions and some Weekend team positions shall be filled through a discernment process that accepts nominations from community members.


Any Cum Christo community member in good standing may nominate a Cursillista or may self-nominate for any leadership position in the Cum Christo Movement. Potential candidates will be discerned through submission of a standardized *Letter of Intent to Serve* and a *Personal Letter of Qualifications*.

**Key Elements of this Process are:**

The Leader Discernment Team	Letter of Intent to Serve (the document)
The Cum Christo Call (Quiri article)	Weekend Team Selection
The Letter of Intent to Serve (standardized application form)	Three Year Term Proposal
