Cum Christo is based on the Roman Catholic Cursillo movement, which was founded in Spain in 1947. It was introduced in Columbus in 1964 and became *Cum Christo*, a diocesan-based ecumenical program, in 1986.

Because of Cum Christo, thousands of lives in this community have been transformed. Many churches and parishes have been energized. Jesus has been recognized as being not only our redeemer, but also our very much alive brother.
