One of my favorite scripture passages is Psalms 46:10 -
"Be still and know that I am the Lord." Cum Christo
friends years ago gave me a desk plaque with this say-
ing on it. I also have a nice framed plaque with this
saying on it hanging in my office as well as my business
card.

Life is busy and hectic. Often we just seem to go from
one thing to another, day in and day out. So often we
rely on self, and only self. Where does God fit into things?
I'm not sure. I just know often I think, how great I'm
doing. How much I have accomplished and completed.
How I have met the many needs of the parish: hospital
visitations; meeting with families and planning funerals
and being sure I have the information needed to deliver
a homily that reflects the individual Christian life and
service; parish finance meetings and budget reviews; pre-
