“WEEKEND” Reminders:

Sponsors: Please do not drop off your candidate before 7 PM on Thursday evening. There is a food pantry at the complex that operates between the hours of 5–7 PM, and people are walking through the parking lot. Please be cautious and watchful for pedestrians. Also, it is best if you can drop off your palanca on Thursday evening as it will simplify the task of the palanca sorters.

Kitchen Volunteers & Others: Please enter the Ministry Center via the west side kitchen door, and quietly, during your scheduled times. The back door to the Ministry Center is kept locked at all times, and the doorbell is very loud and rings throughout the entire building, which would be very interruptive to the Weekend. **Kitchen volunteer slots have been filled.** Questions, please contact Susan Eyerman at meemeye@gmail.com or 740-503-1939.

Palanca: Anyone who wishes to mail or hand-deliver palanca can either send or drop it off at:

- at St. James the Less Ministry Center, west side kitchen door (**only**):
 - Thursday evening,
 - after school Friday (3:30 PM on....),
 - Saturday, any time (*morning, day, evening*), when Kitchen volunteers are on-site, and/or
 - Sunday at Serenade or b/4 10 AM.

Please **DO NOT** bring your palanca to the Ministry Center except during these times and please be respectful of St. James the Less School and pantry hours/events. Palanca should **not** be sent or delivered to St. James the Less Parish office. The door to the Ministry Center is kept locked at all times, and the doorbell is very loud and rings throughout the entire building, which would be very interruptive to the Weekend. There will be a drop box at the Ministry Center kitchen side door. If you have food palanca and other larger items, please drop them off during the day at the Ministry Center, west side kitchen door, during the above times, when kitchen staff is on-site, working. **The deadline for dropping off palanca at the Ministry Center is 10 AM Sunday.**

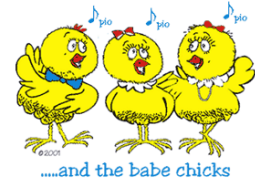

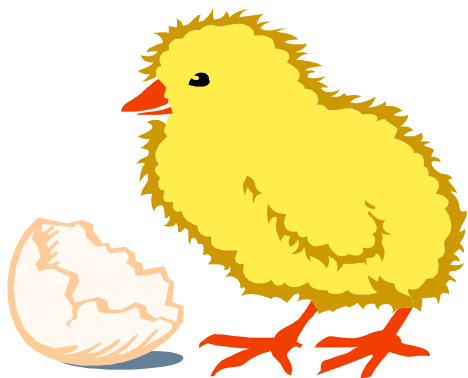
