Sadly, we were also told this year that we can no longer hold our Weekends at the Cum Christo Center due to safety issues with our old building. However, our God is a generous God, and He does provide! He led us to a new venue for our Weekends at The Ministry Center at St. James the Less Parish. We were able to hold a very successful Men's Weekend there in early October, and we are looking forward to our upcoming Women's Weekend, November 12 – 15. While the building is freshly refurbished and very lovely, it of course is not the same as our Cum Christo Center that we have all become so accustomed to. It took a lot of intense effort to prepare The Ministry Center by moving most of our weekend supplies, including some of our beds, Center furniture, a refrigerator and warming oven, and other kitchen supplies. We are so grateful for all of the hard workers who helped to organize what turned out to be a very big project, and for the helping hands that worked so faithfully to make it all happen. We are also very grateful to Fr. Clarence and the staff of St. James the Less Parish for their warm welcome, cooperation, and work in helping us to get settled in. May God abundantly bless all those who gave so generously of their time and effort!

From the Lay Director (cont'd):

Just a few reminders for sponsors and community regarding the Women's Weekend:

- 1) Candidates are to be dropped off at The Ministry Center using the west driveway, no earlier than 7 PM. A food pantry operates out of the basement until 7 PM, so please be very watchful for people in the drive and parking lot;
- 2) Serenade will take place as usual at 6 AM Sunday. The Ministry Center is located in a residential area, and residents will still be sleeping, so please be quiet when arriving – no use of remotes to lock your car and cause a beep, no loud talking and door slamming – we want to be welcomed back! Access to the Center is at the rear of the complex and Team members will let you into the building and direct you to the gathering-serenade location on the first floor. The sleeping rooms are on the second floor and there is no chairlift or elevator.

Sponsors, the pre-weekend cleaning will take place at 9:30 AM on Saturday, November 7. This should take no more than 2 hours. The post-weekend cleanup will be on Monday, November 16 at 6 PM, and again should not take long. A good showing of workers will make it go quickly. Any Cursillistas who have a little time to help (how about a few babe chicks from the Men's Weekend??) would be gratefully accepted. Sponsors, please remember that if you are unable to come yourself, you are requested to find a substitute.

Please note: As The Ministry Center is smaller in size than our CC Center, the Men's Weekend Team, having experienced space constrictions, recommended that we limit the number of candidates on a weekend to 20. So for upcoming Weekends, any applications received beyond 20 paid candidates will have to be placed on a waiting list, and candidates and sponsors will be so informed.

In this issue of the Quiri you will find information on a new initiative for encouraging greater involvement in the movement. You are now able to submit your name or the name of another Cursillista for consideration for various leadership positions or weekend team membership. Due to space constraints in this Quiri (we need to include team and candidate names and the prayer vigil list, as well as names of our new babe chicks from the Men's Weekend) we are not able to provide complete information, but there will be handouts available at the Women's Closing and at our Ultreyas, and information will also be available on the website as soon as we can make that happen.

Finally, please watch for our annual **Sustaining Fund** mailing. We have been operating under heavier than usual financial burdens this year, at least in part due to paying additional rent monies for the use of the St. James Ministry Center for our Fall Weekends. All of our operating expenses have increased while our donations have decreased. The mailing will go out in mid-November and we ask you to reach a little deeper into your pockets and be as generous as possible. Any funds not needed for actual expenses will go into our Sustaining Fund, to help ensure the future of our Cum Christo Movement.

In closing, a few words for thought: *"If you pray for the entire community, then the prayer of the community will come back to you. This is because you form a part of the whole. So you can thus obtain great benefits. The prayer of each member of the people of God is enriched by the prayer of the rest."* (St. Ambrose) And from St. John Paul II: *"This is the 'Communion of Saints' which we profess in the Creed. The good of all becomes the good of each one and the good of each one becomes the good of all."*

Thank you to everyone who has contributed to the 2014-2015 Sustaining Fund Drive.


Our **2015-2016 Sustaining Fund Drive** will begin Thanksgiving Weekend, so please be watching your mailbox.

The Cum Christo Call

It is always a blessing, honor, and privilege to serve God in any capacity in the Cum Christo Movement. Our Cum Christo Weekend taught us that we do not serve for our own glorification, but for the glorification of God and the salvation of others. We live what it means to be a Christian; we live in the life of Grace.

When we seek to serve God as servant-leaders in Cum Christo, we should first pray and reflect, seeking to do God's will. When we prepare a *Letter of Desire to Serve* in a leadership position in the Cum Christo Movement we should pray that this is a calling and should treat the calling with awe, reverence, and respect. After submitting your *Letter of Desire to Serve* [**See modified version on next page**] and you are called to a certain leadership position, praise and thank God. If you are not called to serve at this particular time, please do not be discouraged. Your *Letter of Desire to Serve* shall be kept confidential and on file for future reference for two years after which time it will be shredded. You may update your letter and resubmit it at a later time.

We all need to understand that after submitting a *Letter of Desire to Serve*, there is no guarantee you will be called and there may well be a large number of candidates for a position sought, for example, to be a team member. Also, keep in mind that the discernment process passes through two stages: first, The Leader Discernment Team consisting of five individuals; and second, the Leaders School and Secretariat members, to ensure a just and impartial discernment for each candidate.

Privacy Notice

A candidate's *Letter of Desire to Serve* and *Letter of Qualifications*, which may contain personal information, will never be made public or given to a third party. It shall be held as information within Cum Christo's Leaders School files for the purposes of discernment by the Leaders School members.

Disclaimer - Cursillista's Qualifications

The Leadership Discernment Process is intended to create an open, inclusive, impartial and encouraging discernment process whereby applicants receive fair and just discernment by the Leadership Discernment Team (5 members including the Spiritual Director or his substitute) and Leaders School and Secretariat members. All candidates for a leadership position must recognize that there are many levels and types of personal, spiritual, and experiential qualifications beyond those listed in the By-Laws and Guidelines which may propel one to the top of the list. The Cum Christo Movement, its leadership and members, shall not be held responsible for the acceptance/non-acceptance of any applicant.

The candidate shall be qualified by having been active in Cum Christo Movement positions and activities (*i.e.*, knowledgeable in the Cum Christo Movement's origins, history and traditions; interactive and familiar with past and current leaders and other Cursillistas with leadership ability (*e.g.*, these may include but are not limited to: completion of Weekend Orientation and attendance at Ultreyas, Closings, spiritual and social events);
6. The candidate shall be able to commit to the term of service asked of any particular Section or position; and
7. Additional qualifications for any Leader are listed in the By-Laws and Guidelines for each Section (will be posted, when needed, in the *Quiri Quiri - "The Cum Christo Call"* Section).
